### LEARNING AND TEACHING

- Students will be divided into classes by age, not grade. There may be as much as two years in age difference and 3 grade levels. Small group instruction replaces large group lecture.
- Students will learn at their own pace after determining the instructional level for each.
- Digital software curriculum replaces traditional textbooks.
- Each classroom will have Kindle readers and mini-netbook computers.
- Students will have progress reported as follows:
  - In each core subject, (math, reading, science, social studies) students will have an “academic fingerprint”: Example – Math 2.3, Reading 3.4, Science 4.3, Social Studies 3.8
  - 2.3 = 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, 3<sup>rd</sup> month and so on.
  - 80% mastery required to move forward on each skill
  - Progress measured by computer based assessment (Just like the state testing.)
  - Progress is reported with real time access for parents.
  - Letter grades will be given along with the grade equivalent.

## School Facts:

- ½ Day Kindergarten will be at no cost. Full day Kindergarten will be available for a fee. The fee currently will be \$ 2300 per student. Fee will be reduced if the state increases the amount of funding. Payment can be made monthly. (10 months at \$230 / month)
- Lunch program will be available.
- School day begins for upper grades at 8:05 a.m. and ends at 3:10 p.m.
- School day begins for lower grades at 8:15 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m.
- Before school and after school care programs will be available for a fee. (Please stop and check out the YMCA table for details.)
- School uniforms are on display at the organizational meetings. (Red polo shirts with APA logo in blue and khaki pants. No shorts. Girls may wear khaki skorts. Tennis shoes are acceptable. Plain white preferred. Belts will be black and must be worn. No sagging allowed.)
- Haircuts for boys must be above the ears, off the collars, and bangs above the eyebrows.
- No student is allowed to color his or her hair in any color other than the natural color.
- Girls may have a single post earring in each ear.
- Boys may not wear earrings.
- Students will say “no, sir / ma’am” and “yes, sir / ma’am” and use “please” and “thank you.”
